ELA Summer Reading
2019**

9th grade, 10th grade, 11th grade, 12 grade College Preparatory/ Honors Courses:

- 1) Students should select a text to read (fiction/ non-fiction) appropriate to their reading level and their interest.
- 2) Students should expect to engage in a class assignment during the first quarter of the school year. Information about the assignment will be provided at the start of school. The assignments will be as follows:

9th Grade

- Deliver an oral presentation about the text students read over the summer.
- Students enrolled in Honors courses will produce a written component in addition to the oral presentation.

10th grade

- Based on the reading chosen during the summer, students will engage in a classroom activity, sharing with their classmates the value of the text read
- The assignments may consist of: literary circles, Socratic Seminars, written and oral presentations, or artistic projects.
- Students enrolled in Honors courses will be required to produce a persuasive written assignment, providing evidence from the text they read.

11th Grade

- Students will participate in “My Cape Talk”. The “My Cape Talk” descriptor is: *Over the summer you were asked to select a reading of your choice. During the first quarter of school, you will prepare a short speech to present to your peers that contains information about your reading and persuades your peers as to whether or not they should read it, incorporating evidence and persuasive appeals.*
- Students enrolled in Honors courses must provide a written copy of their speech that includes a minimum of three pieces of textual evidence.

12th Grade

- All 12th grade students should be prepared to have their summer reading assessed by choosing one of the following:
 - CSET
 - Reader Response Essay
 - Keynote / Prezi / Power Point
 - Podcast

*Students enrolled in Honors will choose TWO items from the above list.
